**8 EMBRACE THE POP-UP CULTURE** Keep your eyes peeled for pop-ups: **Joe Chef** and **Jilly Wines** in Clunes as well as **Shoza Gyoza**, **Francisco's Table** and **Il Carretto** pizza van, which pop up in and around Byron.

**.10. MARKET MADNESS**  
 Take a basket to pick up cheeses and other goodies at farmers' markets in **Bangalow**, **Byron Bay**, **New Brighton** and **Mullumbimby**. You can also head to the hinterland and follow the farmgate trail where, along the way, you can invest in local honesty boxes, which sell surplus fruit and vegetables grown in private patches ([byron-bay.com](http://byron-bay.com)).
